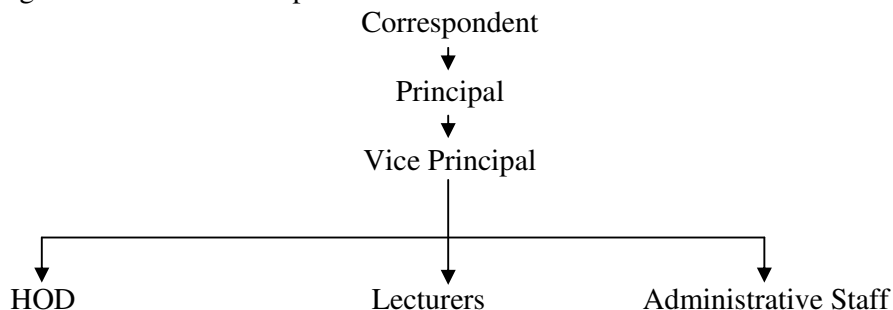

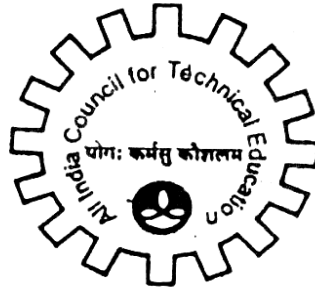

The Jesuits are members of the Society of Jesus, one of the religious orders or organizations in the Catholic Church, founded by St. Ignatius of Loyola. The Society of Jesus is a World Wide Organization of religious men, numbering about 20,000 spread all over the world, of whom nearly 4000 are working in the 18 Provinces of India. In Andhra Pradesh alone there are 205 Jesuits working in Schools and Colleges, Parishes, Social work centres, Tribal areas and other apostolate.

The Degree College by the society was started in 1978 with the affiliation of Osmania University. At present, we have 17 courses at Degree level. In 1992, the University Grants Commission approved the autonomous status, with the concurrence of the State Government and Osmania University. Another important development of Loyola Academy is the starting of MCA from the academic year 1993-94 and MBA in 2000-01. M.Sc. (Chemistry) was started from 2003-04 along with B.Com (Regular). M.Sc. (Physics) P.G. course was started in 2005-06. One new PG course M.Sc. (Biotechnology) commenced from 2006-07. B.A (Psychology) English Literature & Journalism has been introduced from 2006-07. Two new UG courses viz. B.Sc. (Biotechnology, Biochemistry & Chemistry) and B.Sc. (Mathematics, Statistics & Computer Science) have been introduced from 2007-08. Three new UG courses viz. B.Sc. (Animation Design), B.A. (Economics, Maths and Computer Applications) and B.A. (History, Sociology & Public Administration) have been added during the year 2008-09.

One of the encouraging factors is the commencement of campus interview of our UG & PG final year students by various firms and companies.
